

AV Requirements

Robert uses his Apple MacBook Pro when giving presentations unless he is simply talking. He requires a projector and projection screen. His MacBook Pro has USB-C outputs but he usually has necessary adapters with him to connect to standard VGA or HDMI input. If you do not have a data projector available, please let Robert know ahead of time and he may be able to bring one. The room should also be out of direct sunlight if a data projector is being used. Depending on the type of presentation he is giving, he may also need to connect his laptop to the room sound system which can be done via a standard 3.5mm audio port.

Unless the room is large, noisy, or has poor acoustics, a microphone is typically not necessary. If a microphone is required, Robert prefers a wireless lapel mic because he tends to walk around the room when making presentations.
